Devotional Reading

In *The Chronicles of Narnia*, C.S. Lewis' character Aslan, a massive lion, has been said to represent Christ. Indeed, he is the lion of Judah in Revelation 5:5-6. The metaphor is fitting to represent the kingly glory that is Jesus, deserving of all of our honor and praise. Sometimes, however, we tend to put Jesus in a box rather than recognizing the massive power that he has over heaven and earth.

During the end times, the earth will be faced with the full power of God - such a glory we have never before seen. When we can't physically see the power of the Lord at work, it's difficult to remember his true strength, and indeed, it is important that we keep it in the forefront of our minds to prepare for the end.

Seeing God for who he is, rather than who we want him to be, reminds us of the power that awaits us in eternity and gives us a reason to patiently wait for the end of days when we can spend eternity with Christ. Only during that time will we bear witness to the true power of God, when "the day of the Lord will come like a thief, and then the heavens will pass away with a roar, and the heavenly bodies will be burned up and dissolved, and the earth and the works that are done on it will be exposed."
