### Devotional Reading

Our relationships are likely to be unsuccessful if they're lacking one key ingredient: commitment.

Without a diligent dedication to our spouse, our friends, or our church family, our imperfections (meshed with their imperfections) will ultimately result in a failed relationship.

Our relationship with Jesus Christ also necessitates a level of commitment on our part. He is faithfully and unwaveringly committed to us, that we need not question! As our Lord and Savior, Jesus deserves our deepest heart's commitment. After all, we have the hope of spending eternity with him in the Kingdom of God where peace and his glory reigns.

As we move closer to the end times, Peter tells us what sort of people we should be as we wait. Peter writes, "Be diligent to be found by him without spot or blemish and at peace." (v.11) He knows that there will be those on the earth who shirk their commitment to God and start questioning him instead. We are called to diligence in our seeking of the Lord and living godly lives. May this diligence be our response to God's lavish and forgiving love poured over us. His blood removes the blemishes and sets us free.

Our diligence to walk blamelessly in Christ is essential as we actively wait to fully embrace the righteousness and peace of the Lord. May we be prepared for the end by pursuing his Kingdom now.
