Living With Purpose

With Purpose Comes Opposition

- **Ridicule**

"...He ridiculed the Jews, and in the presence of his associates and the army of Samaria, he said, 'What are those feeble Jews doing? Will they restore their wall? Will they offer sacrifices? Will they finish in a day? Can they bring the stones back to life from those heaps of rubble—burned as they are?

... What they are building—if even a fox climbed up on it, he would break down their wall of stones."
Nehemiah 4:1-3 (NIV)

- **Physical Threat- Fear**

"They all plotted together to come and fight against Jerusalem and stir up trouble against it."
Nehemiah 4:8 (NIV)

"But they thought to do me harm." *Nehemiah 6:2 b (NIV)*

- **Manipulation**

"They were all trying to frighten us, thinking, 'Their hands will get too weak for the work, and it will not be completed.'" Nehemiah 6:9 (NIV)
