

Today's Message: "The Ways of Jesus"

- A. God wants us to have the Ways of Jesus
- a. It's God's process with the end result being Transformation

- B. God initiates the process through Revelation

*<sup>50</sup> And Jesus cried out again with a loud voice and yielded up his spirit. <sup>51</sup> And behold, the curtain of the temple was torn in two, from top to bottom. And the earth shook, and the rocks were split. (Matthew 27:50-51, ESV)*

- C. Obedience is our part in the process

- a. Hebrew word for obey is shama. It is a root word meaning "to hear intelligently; to consider and consent with contentment; to diligently discern and perceive with the ear; to give ear."
- b. Hebrew word for obey is hupakouo.
- c. Obedience is not an option.
- d. Obedience to God bring us near to God.

*Jesus answered him, "If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him. (John 14:23, ESV)*

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- D. The end result is Transformation - an inward spiritual renewing of the mind that will manifest in outward actions

*And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, [a] are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another. For this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit. ( 2 Corinthians 3:18, ESV)*
