"Timothy has just returned, bringing us good news about your faith and love... because you have remained strong in your faith. It gives us new life to know that you are standing firm in the Lord. How we thank God for you! Because of you we have great joy as we enter God's presence. Night and day we pray earnestly for you, asking God to let us see you again to fill the gaps in your faith." We are either missionaries or we are a mission field.
(See Luke 10:2)

1. Along with recognition of our own brokenness, we recognize as well our own blessedness.

"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, even as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him. In love he predestined us for adoption as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will, to the praise of his glorious grace, with which he has blessed us in the Beloved." (Ephesians 1:3-6 ESV)

2. We join God in his work of renewal, which often includes tending to the most vulnerable.

"Religion that is pure and undefiled before God, the Father, is this: to visit orphans and widows in their affliction, and to keep oneself unstained from the world." (James 1:27, ESV)

Fear: I'm afraid what could happen next.
Disobedience: I refuse to go on.
Ignorance: I didn't know there was more.
Comfort: I'm comfortable stopping right here.
Discouragement: I'm discouraged about what's happened before.

3. We understand our Christian calling to care for the vulnerable, and we fulfill our unique roll in that call.
