Repent (Israel did not do this)

⁷ *When the people of Israel cried out to the Lord on account of the Midianites,*
⁸ *the Lord sent a prophet to the people of Israel.*

There's a huge difference between **regret** and repentance.

For godly grief produces a repentance that leads to salvation without regret, whereas worldly grief produces death. (2 Corinthians 7:10, ESV)

Remove

²⁵ *...the Lord said to him, "...pull down the altar of Baal that your father has, and cut down the Asherah that is beside it..."*

²⁷ *So Gideon took ten men of his servants and did as the Lord had told him...*

²⁸ *When the men of the town rose early in the morning, behold, the altar of Baal was broken down, and the Asherah beside it was cut down...*

Therefore, my beloved, flee from idolatry. (1 Corinthians 10:14, ESV)

Replace

²⁶ *"...build an altar to the Lord your God on the top of the stronghold here, with stones laid in due order.
